How to get here

By Car

Our Middlesbrough office is located close to the A66 to provide easy access, take the Middlesbrough Centre (E) exit head towards Centre Square. A few key driving routes are listed for you below:

From Leeds

M1, A1(M), A168 and A19 to Middlesbrough. Take the exit toward Middlesbrough Centre (E) from A66.

From Newcastle

A184 and A19 to Middlesbrough. Take the exit toward Middlesbrough Centre (E) from A66.

From Preston

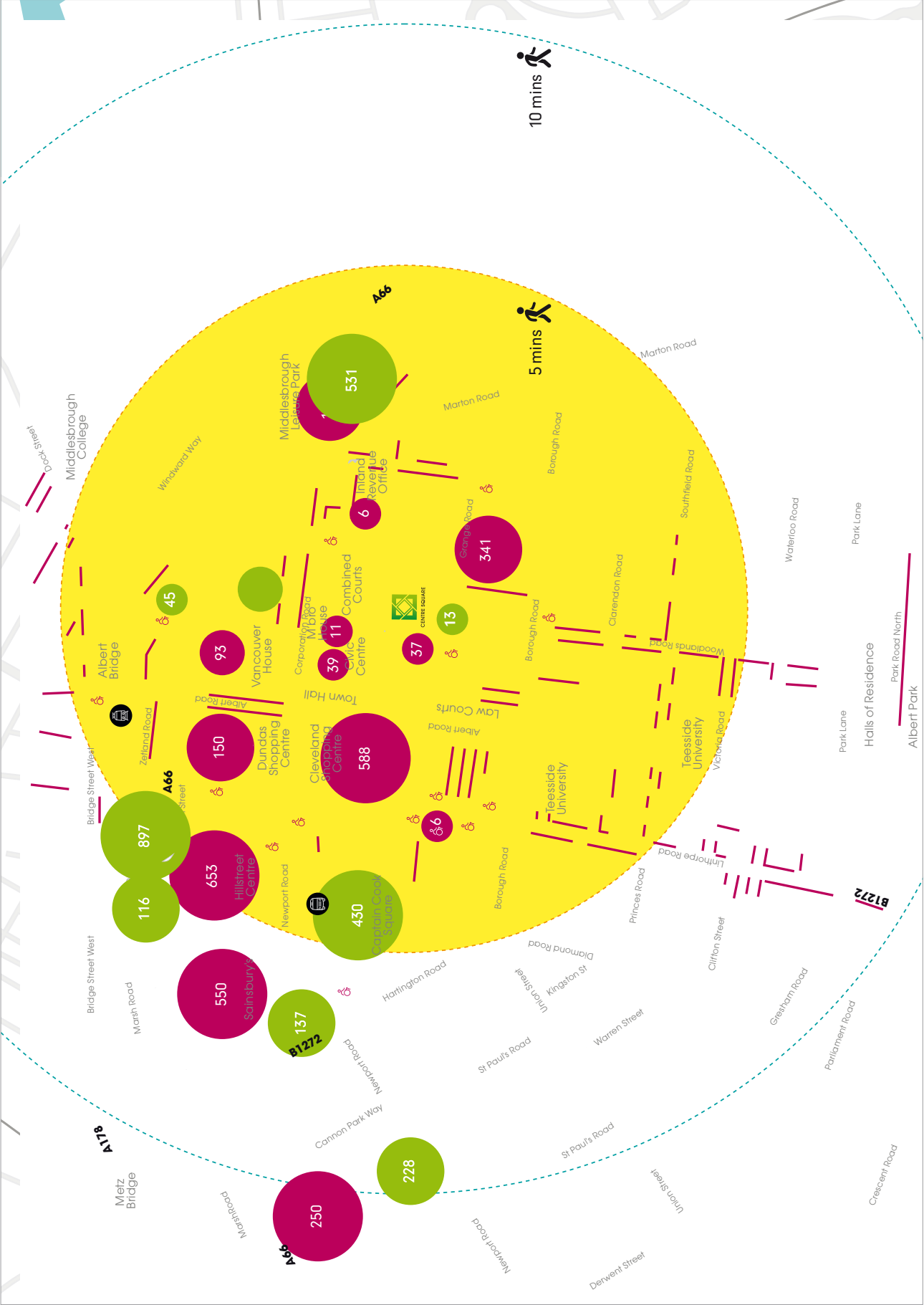
M6, A685 and A66 to Middlesbrough. Take the exit toward Middlesbrough Centre (E) from A66

There are a wealth of car parks once you arrive in Middlesbrough within a 5-minute walk of our office. Please see car parking options map on the following page. Where possible, we'd recommend parking at the following car parks:

By Train

Our office is just a short 10-minute walk away from Middlesbrough train station which benefits from direct links to London Kings Cross and good links to Newcastle and Manchester.

Upon your arrival at Middlesbrough train station, make your way out of the train station onto Albert Road, head south until you reach HSBC bank on your left. On this corner, turn left down Corporation Rd., past Middlesbrough Town Hall and Civic Centre until you see a large glass building with yellow columns and a dome entrance on your right-hand side. The Causeway office is between the Council building and the Courts.

Newcastle

Trains run throughout the day with a few trains arriving every hour from Newcastle with direct services taking approx. 1 hour.

Manchester Victoria

Trains run throughout the day with one train arriving every hour from Manchester Victoria with direct services taking approx. 2 hours.

Accessing the building

The entrance to Building One, Centre Square is located just off Corporation Road, next to Elm Street. Once you've entered the main building, please head up to the third floor and follow the corridor round to the right for the main Causeway reception. Please ring the buzzer and one of our receptionists will greet you upon arrival and give you a temporary access card so you can move freely around the building.
